WHAT IS A TRAINEE NURSING ASSOCIATE (TNA)?

The TNA course is for those who have some experience of working in health or social care and have also attained their Level 2 in English and Maths.

Candidates will learn the clinical skills and knowledge to work at a Band 4 Nurse Associate level and will take part in clinical placements.

The TNA programme is predominately nursing based and will be regulated by the Nursing & Midwifery Council. Once on the register, candidates will be able to administer and manage patient medication.

At the point of registration, TNAs will demonstrate skills in assessment, but not at a level that would enable them to lead these activities as newly qualified professionals. However, you can top up to full registration via the Two Year Nurse Apprenticeship.
